Mill and Inlay includes removing all the existing distressed asphalt and replacing with new pavement. The existing asphalt is removed, stockpiled, and often reused by the City of Midland Transportation Division for street and alley maintenance, or it is blended and reused to make new hot mix asphalt. The Sinclair Mill and Inlay Road Bond Project includes the repaving of Sinclair from Midland Drive to Loop 250.

We have reviewed the bid tabulation for the Sinclair Mill and Inlay Road Bond Project. Jones Brothers Dirt and Paving Contractors, Inc. is the apparent low bidder and has a track record of successfully completing work in the City of Midland and the surrounding area. In addition, the unit prices appear to be in line with current pricing trends. Therefore, we are recommending award of the Sinclair Avenue Mill and Inlay Bond Project to Jones Brothers Dirt and Paving Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$670,266.29 (Base Bid + 5% Contingency).

**Funding Source:** The funds are available in Fund 120, the Road Bond Projects CIP, and will be appropriated to a project for the purpose identified.
